Science – Electricity

In Science, we will be identifying common appliances that run on electricity.

We will be able to construct a simple series electrical circuit, identifying and naming its basic parts, including cells, wires, bulbs, switches and buzzers.

Later in the term we will investigate conductors and insulators as well as using switches.

Maths –

Following on from Autumn 2 we will be completing more work on multiplication and division before learning about measures and perimeter. We will also complete fraction work in this term.

Volcanoes Geography

In Geography this term, we will be looking at well-known volcanoes and their place in the world. We will discover why people choose to live near volcanoes and what leads to a volcano erupting.

In Spring 2, we will be looking at the History of the Forest of Dean.

French

Birthday Celebrations and Colourful Creatures will see Larches be able to count up to 31, look at dates and say our age. We will then look at animals and colours in French.
