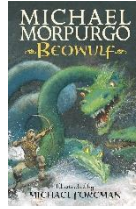

Anglo-Saxons vs the Vikings (History)

We will be using our history skills to discover what life was like in Anglo-Saxon Britain and what happened when the Vikings came to the country.
