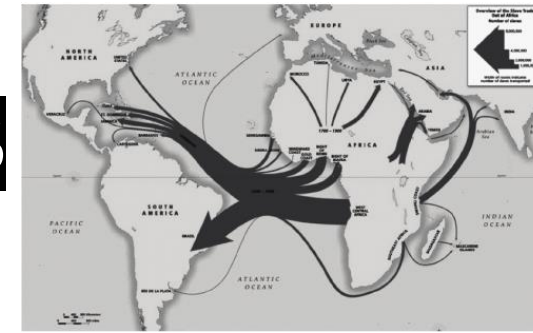

Curriculum Drivers: Aspiration Contribution Exploration

Science – SPACE

In this term, we will be starting with our space topic which includes exploration into the earth, moon and sun to understand our world as well as looking at other planets in the solar system.

Our second topic will be animals including humans focusing on change and reproduction.

English –

We will be using our class book, Cosmic, to create a narrative piece of writing and explore a space journal to create our own. There will be many opportunities for writing to become cross-curricular this term with our link to space. We will later be reading Freedom 1783.

PE – Swimming and Prostars

PE will take place on Monday (Y5 Swimming, Y6 with Miss Briggs) and Thursday afternoons – please ensure you bring in swimming kits/ come in your kits for these days.

The Atlantic Slave Trade (History)

We will be using our history skills to discover what happened in the days of slavery including crossing the Atlantic. We will be using sources to find out more about what life was like for slaves.

In **Geography**, we will be looking at Africa which will include identifying countries in the continent of Africa and how we can use more advanced compass directions and skills.

French –

Clothes and the French weather are our main focus for Spring term but we might also be able to look at some space related vocabulary!

Maths –

We will be building upon our core knowledge of the four operations- add, subtract, multiplication and division- and applying this to more complex methods. Fractions, decimals and percentages will be our core focus this term.
