Graduated Pathway for Children with SEND

Parents, school, health or social care have a concern about a child

- Discussions with teachers during Pupil Progress meetings
- Information from assessments/Intervention monitoring

Child completes a My Profile with adult

Meeting arranged with child's parents/SENCO/Class teacher and any initial actions agreed
Teacher to gather information and monitor progress.

Place at 'Target Child' category

Agree timescales for a review



Review after an agreed period: Is the child making adequate progress against targets?

<p>Significantly below chronological age in standardised assessments</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Glos Guidance has been consulted and child needs provision at a 'targeted' level (beyond universal) ➤ Child requires provision that is different from or additional to provision provided to all children. 	<p>No further action required Continue to monitor closely.</p>



SENDCO to place child on SEND register after a consultation with parents.
Class teacher and parents to write a My Plan with SMART Targets. Targets to be shared with child in appropriate language



My Plan Review.
Meet with parents and review My Plan
Set new SMART Targets for child for at least two My Plan reviews.



Does the child require additional provision than that set out in the My Plan after two My Plan reviews?
e.g. Child is not meeting outcomes on My Plan. Child not making progress from starting point/baseline.

SENDCO/ Class teacher and parents to complete a My Assessment
Refer to external agencies e.g. AT, EPS

Review termly

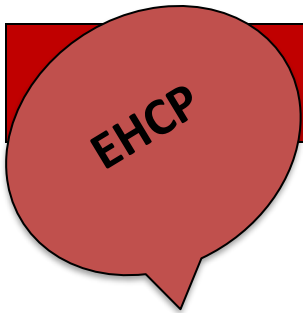
Continue with My Plan +.
